

To elect a President and 5 members for Board of Directors BSE calls for its AGM 2022

The Bahrain Society of Engineers announced the date of its Annual General Assembly Meeting. The first meeting of the AGM will be held at the BSE headquarters on Wednesday evening 8th June 2022 while the second meeting is scheduled for Sunday evening 19th June 2022.

BSE also announced names of the candidates for the position of President and the candidates to fill the four new seats on the Board of Directors, in addition to another member for the remaining period due to the resignation of one of the members.

The BSE closed the door for applying for candidacy after the declared period has lapsed at four o'clock in the afternoon of Tuesday, 17th May 2022, according to the circular sent in advance to the members of the BSE. The list of candidates was approved in a previous meeting after verifying all candidacy applications.

Three candidates have applied for the position of President of the Society: Dr. Raeda Sayed Kadhem Al-Alawi, Engineer Fouad Ahmed Al-Shaikh, and Dr. Wafaa Abdul Rahman Al-Mansoori.

Meanwhile, nine candidates for the membership of the Board of Directors have submitted for the offices: Engineer Samir Ebrahim Buhaimed, Engineer Sheikha Sultan Al Khalasi, Engineer Adnan Ali Al Rahma, Engineer Farid Ismail Boushahri, Engineer Marjan Abdel Rasool Madara, Engineer Mahdi Taher Al Jalawi, Engineer Nozha Abdulla Abu Hindi, Engineer Huda Sultan Mubarak and Engineer Heyam Mohamed Al-Maskati.

The meeting of the general assembly will be held in person at the BSE's headquarters in Juffair, in which the minutes of the previous general assembly meeting will be ratified, the report of the Board of Directors on the work of the ended session will be discussed, the financial report of the BSE will be reviewed, in addition to the election of the president and four new members to the Board of Directors and the election of one member of the Board of Directors whose term of office shall be one year to complete the term of the resigned member.

BSE meets Her Excellency the Secretary-General of the Supreme Council for Women



A delegation from the Bahrain Society of Engineers met H.E. Ms. Halah Al-Ansari, Secretary-General of the Supreme Council for Women (SCW), on Wednesday 18th May 2022.

The BSE's delegation was headed by Dr. Dheya Tawfiqi, the BSE's President, and in the presence of Eng. Mohamed Ali Al-Khuzae, BSE's Vice President, Dr. Raeda Al-Alawi, BSE's Treasurer, and Eng. Habib Al-Jaboori, Director of Activities and Community Service Committee. The purpose of the visit was to honor the SCW, being one of the institutions that have supported the activities of the BSE. This visit coincided with the BSE's Golden Jubilee celebrations.

Dr. Dheya Tawfiqi presented H.E. Ms. Halah Al-Ansari a copy of the book "50 Years of Excellence and Achievements," which covered the history of the BSE since its incorporation, and a special chapter on women engineers.

H.E. Mrs. Al-Ansari stressed the importance of highlighting the success stories of Bahraini women in

various engineering disciplines, studying ways to address the challenges they face, and activating policies to integrate women's needs and ensure their sustainability in the engineering sector.

For his part, Dr. Dheya Tawfiqi praised the efforts of the Supreme Council for Women under the chairmanship of Her Royal Highness Princess Sabeeka bint Ibrahim Al Khalifa, wife of H.M. the King, in promoting the principle of equal opportunities between women and men in the engineering sector, in a way that guarantees their access to training and promotion opportunities and develop beyond the regional and global horizons. Dr. Tawfiqi expressed the BSE keenness to draw inspiration from the Council's directions and guidelines in terms of supporting the progress and competitiveness of Bahraini women in this field. He praised the partnership between the Council and the Society, which vastly contributed in creating programs and activities that greatly contributed to encouraging women to enter qualitative engineering specializations that keep pace with the current and future labour market requirements.

Signing a memorandum of understanding between BSE and CRPEP

The memorandum of understanding was signed by Dr. Dheya Tawfiqi, President of the BSE, while it was signed on behalf the council's by Engineer Maryam Ahmed Jamaan, Chairperson of the Council for Regulating the Practice of Engineering Professions.

It is noteworthy that the Young Engineers Forum of the Bahrain Society of Engineers was established to achieve several goals, including creating opportunities for young engineers to engage in the BSE's committees

and work more and encouraging them to work in the forum, providing them an opportunity to transfer knowledge and experience in the engineering field to the younger generation, and creating opportunities for young engineers to learn closely on the work mechanism at the BSE, its procedures and regulations, and creating opportunities or a platform for young engineers to discuss engineering issues, especially those related to youth and their aspirations and ambitions.

Extensive fields have been identified through the forum, and among those fields are the topics of engineering seminars and conference-related and targeted to young engineers, organizing professional programs for young engineers, submitting articles and research related to youth for *Almohandis* magazine and for all publications of the BSE, and organizing periodical events such as forums or conferences for young people, or any other fields to be agreed upon.
